The Peter Rollins Travel Grant for Early-Career Faculty to the National Conference

Application Instructions:

To be considered for the Rollins Travel Grant, individuals must:

1. Fill out this application.
2. Include the abstract that was submitted for the national program.
3. Write a one page (250 words or fewer) statement discussing:
 - The thesis and scope of the presentation
 - The extent to which the paper reflects and contributes to the study of Popular Culture and/or American Culture Studies
 - How this paper will contribute to your future professional goals

Applicants must have received their doctorate (PhD) within the four years prior to the national conference. They may be tenure-stream, non-tenure stream, or independent scholars. Applicants should complete the application process and submit it electronically to **Michael.Schoenecke@ttu.edu** by no later than **December 31** of the year prior to the national conference. Please note that applicants may apply for only one PCA/ACA grant in any given year.
